
REDcycle - soft plastic recycle

Soft plastics (the type that scrunch in your hands) can be recycled through a program called REDcycle. Not yet available commercially, you can still participate by collecting your soft plastics and dropping them off at a participating Coles or Woolworths. It's easy to do!

How to participate

1. Find your nearest drop off point at www.redcycle.net.au/where-to-redcycle.



- 2. Set up a bin back-of-house to collect your soft plastic.
- 3. Affix our signage on the bin (utilise the back of this sheet). Educate your staff on what can be REDcycled. Ensure any soft plastics collected are clean and dry.
- 4. Bag up your soft plastics and take them to the drop off point.
