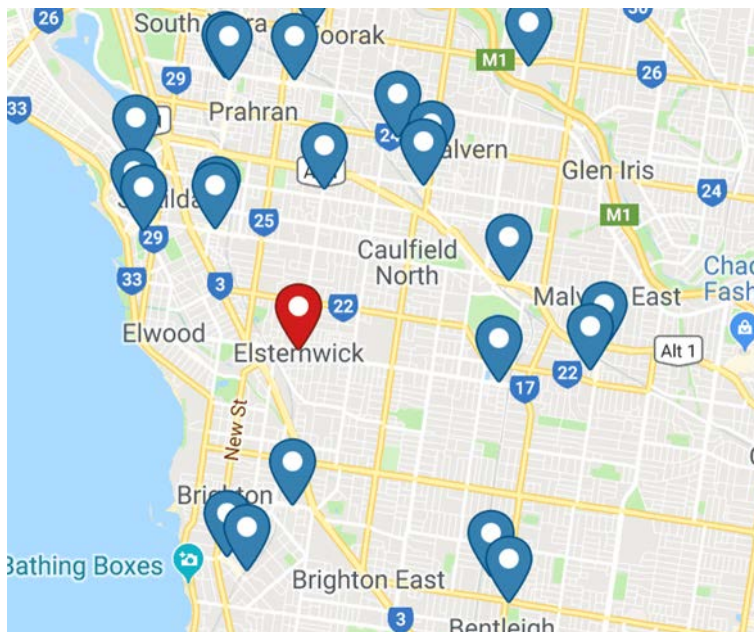


REDcycle – soft plastic recycle

Soft plastics (the type that scrunch in your hands) can be recycled through a program called REDcycle. Not yet available commercially, you can still participate by collecting your soft plastics and dropping them off at a participating Coles or Woolworths. It's easy to do!

How to participate

1. Find your nearest drop off point at www.redcycle.net.au/where-to-redcycle.



2. Set up a bin back-of-house to collect your soft plastic.
3. Affix our signage on the bin (utilise the back of this sheet). Educate your staff on what can be REDcycled. Ensure any soft plastics collected are clean and dry.
4. Bag up your soft plastics and take them to the drop off point.

- Paper & cardboard
